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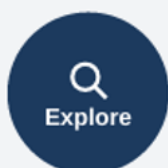

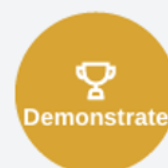

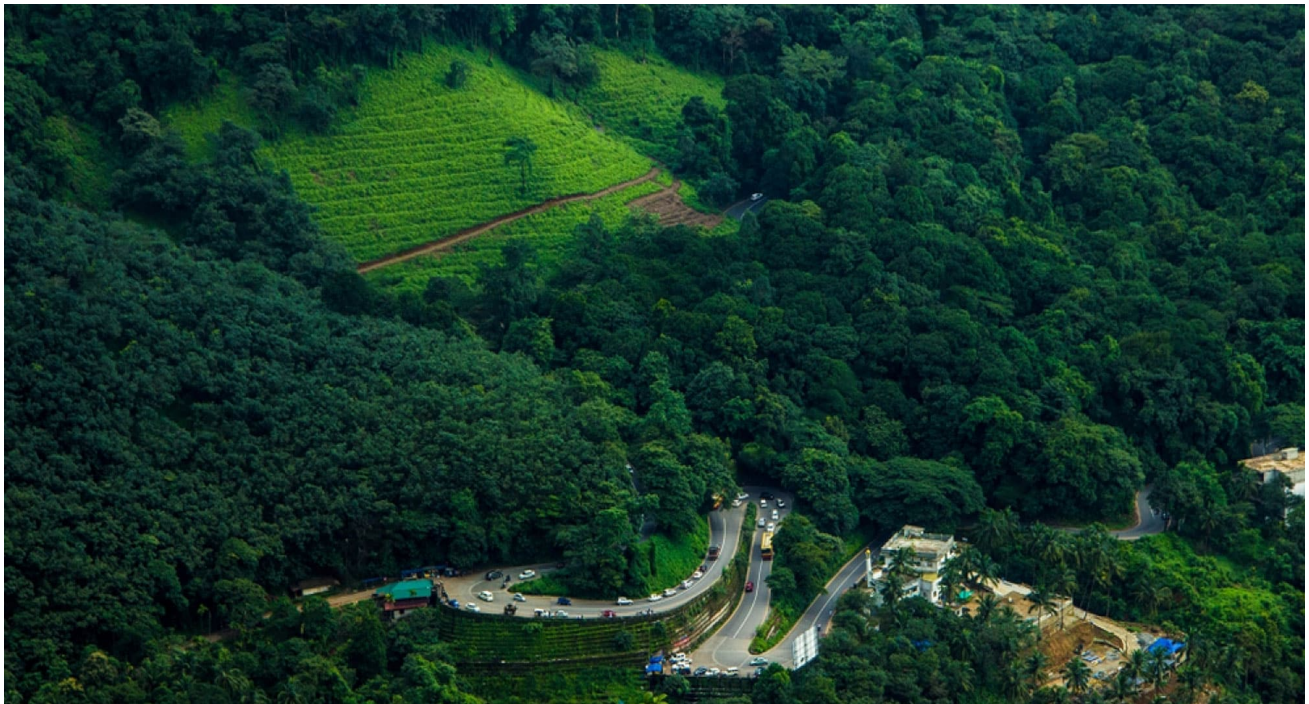

Exploring Forest Ecosystems, Waterfalls & Coastal Sustainability

08:30 AM – Departure to Kozhikode

09:30 AM – Scenic Drive Through Thamarassery Churam (45 km | 1.5 hrs)

“Where the mountains unfold in endless curves of mist and wonder.”

Known for its iconic hairpin bends and breathtaking valley views, Thamarassery Churam offers students a dramatic encounter with the engineering brilliance and ecological significance of mountain passes.

As clouds drift over dense forests and deep valleys, students witness how landscapes influence



transport, biodiversity, settlements, and human movement across regions.

10:30 AM – Trekking at Thusharagiri & Visit Thusharagiri Waterfalls (18 km | 40 mins)

“Where waterfalls thunder through forests and nature reveals its untamed soul.”

Deep within tropical forests, Thusharagiri unfolds as a spectacular cascade where crystal-clear streams tumble through rocks and lush greenery. The trekking trail transforms into a living laboratory of biodiversity, echoing with the sounds of rushing water and the rhythm of untouched wilderness.

Students experience firsthand the importance of river systems, forest ecosystems, rainfall cycles, and environmental conservation while reconnecting with the raw beauty of nature.
